

History Jeffreys Bay



Jeffreys Bay, a coastal town in the Eastern Cape province of South Africa, has a rich and diverse history. Originally inhabited by the Khoisan people, indigenous hunter-gatherers, the area was later settled by the Xhosa people, a Bantu-speaking nation. European explorers, including the Portuguese, visited the area in the 1640s, and by the 1770s, European settlers had established a trading post.

In 1849, the town was named after Captain Jeffrey, a European ship captain who navigated the nearby bay. During the 1800's, Jeffreys Bay developed as a small fishing village and a key stopover for travelers and traders between Cape Town and Port Elizabeth. The town expanded significantly in the 1900s, becoming a popular holiday destination by the 1920s.



Today, Jeffreys Bay is renowned for its world-class surf breaks, beautiful beaches, and vibrant community. Jeffreys Bay is thrilled to host one of the most prestigious stops on the international surfing circuit - the J-Bay Open, part of the World Surf League (WSL) Championship Tour. Every year, the world's top surfers descend upon J-Bay's iconic Supertubes surf break, competing for the coveted title and valuable ranking points. The town's economy thrives on agriculture, fishing, seafood, tourism, and retail sectors. Jeffreys Bay celebrates its heritage through annual festivals like the Winterfest and home to the iconic Shell Museum. 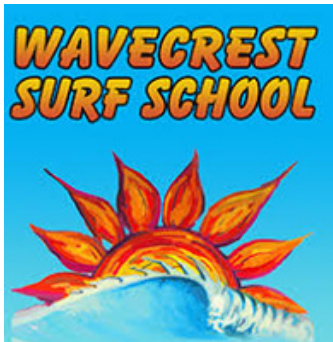

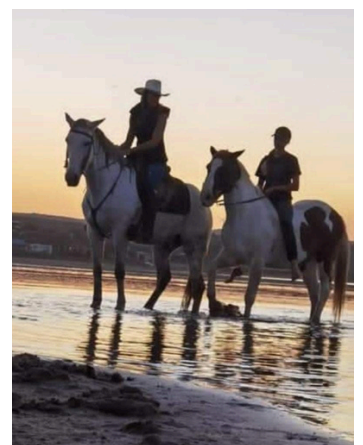

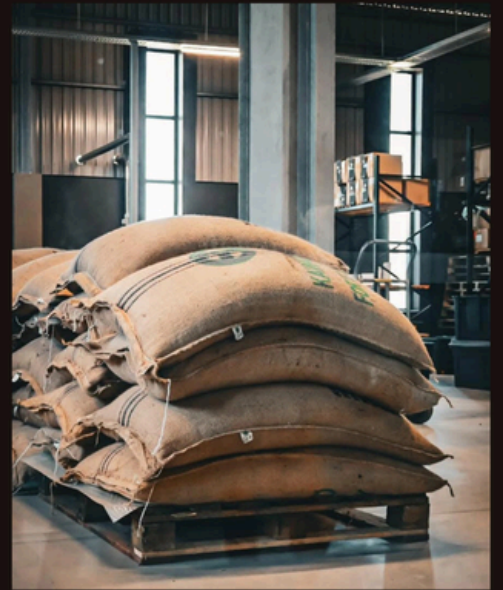

Kabeljous Beach & Lagoon

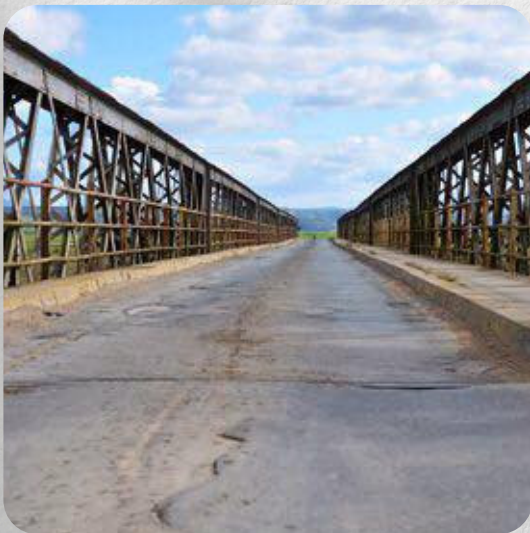

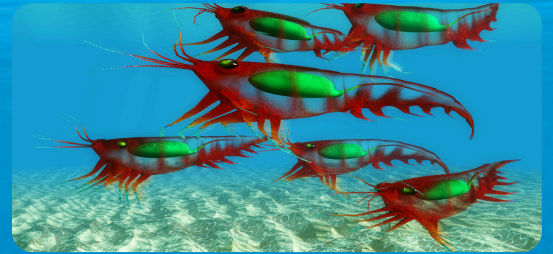

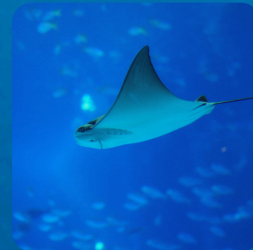
WHALES AND DOLPHINS OF THE EAST AND WESTERN CAPE

WHALE SHARK



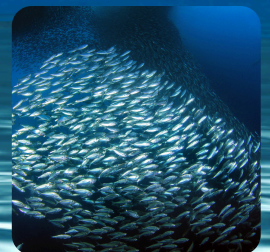
The Whale Shark lives up to 80 years reaching 43-56 feet long.
Diet: Plankton and krill

KILLER WHALE



The Killer Whale lives for 50-100 years and grows up to 25m long.
Diet: Fish, squid, sharks, seals, dolphins and rays

HUMPBACK WHALE



The Humpback Whale lives for 45-50 years reaching 18m long.
Diet: Shrimp, crustaceans and small fishes



BRYDES WHALE



The Bryde's Whale lives for 50-70 years. Grows up to 15m long. Diet: krill, copepods, red crabs, shrimp, and small fish like makrel, pilchards and sardines



INDIAN BOTTLENOSE DOLPHIN



The Indian Bottlenose Dolphin lives for 30-50 years, grows to 2.6m long. Diet: squid, crabs and shrimp



LONG - BEAKED COMMON DOLPHIN



The Long-Beaked Dolphin lives for +-40 years. Grows to 2.5m long. Diet: anchovies, sardines and other schooling fish

WALKING & HIKING THE AREA



Noorsekloof Nature Reserve (Level - Easy)

Distance - 3km

The Noorsekloof Nature Reserve covers 28-hectares of land with a 3 km trail alongside a stream where you can see more than 50 species of birds including the Knysna woodpecker, Knysna loerie, paradise flycatchers, as well as small buck. The reserve is named after the abundance of Noorsboom trees, or giant Euphorbia Triangularus in the area. The trail is free and starts at the entrance to Kloof in Eland Street ending in Dogwood Circle.



Kabeljous Trail - 2km from Jeffreys Bay (Level - Easy) Distance 3 - 7km

The Kabeljous Nature Reserve is a 180 - hectare reserve that includes parts of the Kabeljous River and estuary, as well as extensive wetlands, valleys, forest and 2.5 km of beautiful coastline with vegetated sand dunes. A picnic area is available at the estuary. You can access the trail off the R102 as well as starting on the south side of the estuary, where you can park beside the picnic sites and walk along the banks towards the ocean. With more than 100 bird species in the area and thousands of red - knobbed coots that nest in these waters. You will walk through the coastal thicket with the opportunity to spot bushbuck, duiker and grysbok. The view from the lookout over the coastline and surrounding bush is simply stunning. When walking down dunes or along the beach be sure to watch out for the nests of African Black Oyster Catchers.



Tortoise Trail - 5km from Jeffreys Bay (Level - Easy) suitable for children. Distance 1km

The Tortoise Trail is situated on the Seekoei River Nature Reserve, which lies between the coastal villages of Aston Bay and Paradise Beach, just south of Jeffreys Bay. The reserve is a beautiful place to walk with many trees to observe including Gharrie, Boerboom, Milkwood, Sagewood, Bitou and Aloes. The Tortoise Trail follows a track beginning at the office down to the bird hide on the river banks, where more than 120 bird species have been identified, including the Cape Dabchick and majestic Fish Eagle. In ideal conditions, you can see large flocks of flamingos in the shallow waters. Keep your eyes peeled for the blue duiker, bush buck, tortoise, mongoose and grysbok as you walk along the path.



Oyster Bay, St Francis Bay and Cape St Francis

For the adventurous at heart, an overnight hiking trail will refresh the body and mind. The most well-known is the Chokka Trail, a 62 km slackpacking trail which starts at St Francis Bay, a 30 minute drive from Jeffreys Bay. The trail is a combination of quaint fishing villages and a stunning, unspoiled part of the Eastern Cape brimming with Fynbos, wetlands, sand dunes and a rugged coastline. You only carry a lunch pack whilst your luggage is transported to your next overnight stay, which is comfortable and fully catered for.

ANIMALS IN OUR AREA



At an average weight of 58 kg, the bushbuck is the smallest of the spiral-horned antelopes.

The animal has been known to resemble the lowland nyalas.

Males, also known as rams, and the females, known as ewes, have different physical characteristics. The rams have a fur that is a dark grayish colour.



Porcupines are covered in about 30,000 quills, they cannot throw or shoot their quills. ...

While porcupines spend most of the time on the ground, they are good climbers and regularly climb trees in search of food and occasionally even build nests in trees, they are also good swimmers.



Bushpigs shelter in dense vegetation, and nests may be built during rains or periods of cold.

In addition, wallowing is a favorite activity.

Interestingly, bushpigs are often found following frugivorous monkeys, feeding on uneaten fruit that falls to the ground.

They are notorious for feeding on crops.



Vervets are equally comfortable on the ground as they are in trees.

They are active in the daytime and sleep in trees at night. Excellent communicators, vervets are thought to possess the basics of language, that is, vocal communication through an intricate system of alarm calls.



The yellow mongoose are diurnal which means they are active during the day.

The mongoose is known to rest or sunbathe outside of their dens before beginning to feed, travel and forage for food.

They use tail movements to communicate to others (swishing, flicking and erecting).



The Cape clawless otter has powerful webbed feet, sharp teeth and a long muscular tail which helps them to be successful underwater hunters.

The Cape clawless otter lacks claws, except for on three digits on its hind feet, giving it the "clawless" part of its name.



The name 'Grysbok' is Afrikaans and is a reference to the grey fleck that these antelope have in their otherwise reddish-brown coat.

Sharpe's Grysbok is about 50 cm in height at the shoulder and only the rams have horns.

The horns are normally around 6 cm in length, but some individuals have horns reaching 10 cm.



The Duiker gets its name from the Afrikaans word 'duiker' which means to dive, relating to the animal's habit of ducking away into bushes when danger threatens.

They feed on leaves, fruit and seeds.

They are one of the very few antelope to have been known to eat insects and carrion.



Caracals are the fastest felids of their size! They are also excellent jumpers and climbers.

They are supremely acrobatic and can leap agilely into the air to bring down prey, such as guinea fowl, on the wing.



Tortoises have very small brains. They lay eggs and females will bury their eggs to keep them safe from predators.

A tortoise called Jonathan is currently the longest-living land animal in the world, at 190 years old!

Tortoises have existed for over 55 million years.

The History of Golf

Golf originated from a game played on the eastern coast of Scotland in an area close to the Royal capital of Edinburgh. In those early days, players would attempt to hit a pebble over dunes and around tracks using a bent stick or club. During the 15th century, Scotland prepared to defend itself, yet again, against an invasion by the "Auld Enemy". The nation's enthusiastic pursuit of golf however, led many to neglect their military training, so much so that the Scottish parliament of King James II banned the sport in 1457.

Although people largely ignored the ban, it was only in 1502 that the game gained the royal seal of approval when King James IV of Scotland (1473-1513) became the world's first golfing monarch.

The popularity of the game quickly spread throughout the 16th-century Europe thanks to this royal endorsement. King Charles IV brought the game to England and Mary Queen of Scots introduced the game to France when she studied there. The term "caddie" derives from the name for her French military aids, known as the cadets.

One of the premier golf courses of the day was at Leith near Edinburgh which hosted the first international golf match in 1682, when the Duke of York and George Patterson representing Scotland beat two English Noblemen.

The game of golf officially became a sport when the Gentlemen Golfers of Leith formed the first club in 1744 and set up an annual competition with silverware prizes. The rules for this new competition were drafted by Duncan Forbes.

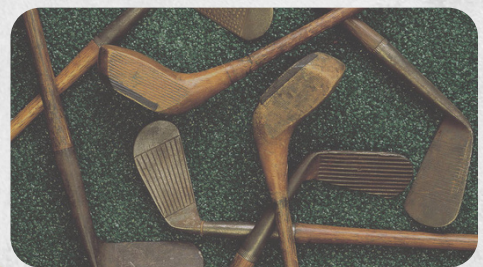
With rules that even today sound so familiar to many: If your ball comes along the watery filth you are at liberty to take out your ball and bring it behind the hazard and tee it, you may play it with any club and allow your adversary a stroke for so getting out your ball.

Chokka Boats and the source of calamari



The South African squid fishery is based on a single species, *Loligo reynaudii*, locally referred to as chokka and also known as squid, calamari or white gold.

Fishing boats out in Jeffreys Bay and St Francis Bay are regular sights to residents and visitors. These boats can often be seen taking shelter in the bays when bad weather is forecast, at night it looks like a town out on the water with all the bright lights out there. The majority of these boats are chokka boats with the region being home to the South African chokka industry.

The squid (or chokka) industry started in the early 1980's with boats landing fresh chokka in Plettenberg Bay and Port Elizabeth and later in St Francis Bay. The export market developed very quickly.



Calamari is not a type of fish but a culinary term for squid.

The word calamari derives from Italian.

Calamari is a good source of vitamin C and iron.

Researchers have established that squid live short lives, as short as 6 months to a year

The largest recovered squid and colossal squid have measured nearly 13m (about 43 feet) long. There are unconfirmed reports of individuals exceeding 20 m (more than 65 feet) in length.

The colossal squid (*Mesonychoteuthis hamiltoni*) is a massive, deep-sea cephalopod that's thought to be one of the largest invertebrates on Earth!
